NOTICE ON OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR SHIP-TO-SHIP (STS) BUNKERING WITHIN BINTULU PORT WATER LIMITS

This Port Notice is issued to provide operational requirements for bunker operator intending to conduct STS bunkering within Bintulu Port water.

1. Application for STS Bunkering Operations

• All applications for STS bunkering operations shall be submitted to Bintulu Port Sdn. Bhd. at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the operation.

2. <u>Automatic Identification System (AIS)</u>

- All vessels involved in STS bunkering operations shall ensure that their AlS system remains operational and always switched on while within Bintulu Port water limits.
- AIS shall remain active during the entire duration of the STS bunkering operation for monitoring and safety purposes.

3. Safety and Compliance

- STS bunkering operations shall be carried out in strict compliance with Bintulu Port Authority By-Laws, IMO guidelines, and other applicable regulations.
- Vessels and operators are to ensure all necessary precautions, including pollution prevention measures and emergency

- preparedness, are in place prior to commencement of the operation.
- The Master of each vessel shall be responsible for ensuring crew awareness and readiness throughout the operation.

4. <u>Monitoring and Enforcement</u>

- Bintulu Port Authority reserves the right to monitor, inspect, suspend, or stop any STS bunkering operation that poses a risk to safety, security, or the environment.
- Non-compliance with this Port Notice may result in enforcement action in accordance with Bintulu Port Authority By-Laws and other relevant laws.

The above notice is enforced with immediate effect until further notice.
